Evaluating PTC Arbortext Editor with Styler

We are pleased to provide this version of PTC Arbortext Editor with Styler for your evaluation. Although we cannot predict exactly how you will use the software during your evaluation, this guide provides some general guidelines for installing and licensing the software and for finding the documentation you need to get started.

PTC Arbortext Editor Evaluation Guide

Please download this guide when installing, licensing, and beginning your evaluation of the software.

PTC Evaluation License Agreement

- Prior to downloading the evaluation software from the PTC web site, you must agree to the terms of the PTC Evaluation License Agreement presented there. That license agreement is duplicated at the end of this document for your reference.
- If you obtained the evaluation software from a PTC source other than the PTC web site, then you must agree to accept the PTC Evaluation License Agreement (also found at the end of this document) before you install the evaluation software.
- If you do not agree to all of the terms of the PTC Evaluation License Agreement, do
 not accept this Agreement and do not download, install, or access the software. If
 you have received a media package containing the software, promptly return the
 software to PTC.
- Choosing CLICK HERE IF YOU AGREE TO ALL OF THE TERMS OF THIS
 AGREEMENT TO DOWNLOAD TRIAL on the PTC Evaluation License Agreement
 screen before downloading means you have read and understand the Agreement,
 and that you and any organization of which you are an employee or representative
 agree to be bound by its terms and conditions.

Download Instructions for PTC Arbortext Editor with Styler

The download, installation, and licensing procedures are described below for installing on Windows for an individual user. To use your PTC Arbortext Editor with Styler software, you must install it from the web download archive or DVD, and request a trial license key to enable it.

This evaluation software release supports both 32-bit and 64-bit versions of Microsoft Windows XP, Windows Vista, and Windows 7.

Downloading PTC Arbortext Editor with Styler for Windows

You must have Administrator privileges to install PTC Arbortext software.

- Navigate to www.ptc.com, go to the Support page, and select the Home tab. On the left side of the page, locate the Free Downloads link and click on it. The Free Downloads page lets you download an evaluation version of PTC Arbortext Editor.
- **2.** You can print or save this Evaluation Guide.
- **3.** Register with PTC if you do not have an account. Fill in the required information on the **New Account** page and click **Create Account**. You will see a confirmation page.
- 4. At the bottom of the **New Account** confirmation page, click **Return to the page** that sent me here to return to the **Free Downloads** page.
- 5. To be able to start your download, you first need to click PTC Arbortext Editor Evaluation Software agreement and accept the PTC Evaluation License Agreement. When you CLICK HERE IF YOU AGREE TO ALL OF THE TERMS OF THIS AGREEMENT TO DOWNLOAD TRIAL, you'll return to a slightly different Free Downloads page for the download.

If you are installing from a DVD, you can skip the download process.

- 6. Under **Download Now**, choose the link for your system (**Windows x32** for 32-bit Windows or **Windows x64** for 64-bit Windows). You'll be asked to **Save File**, and provide a location to save the .zip file.
- 7. Return to the **Free Downloads** page, and find the Request License File section.
- 8. You need the CPU Host ID for the computer where PTC Arbortext Editor will be installed to generate a license key. Click the link for help in finding your Host ID. On the **Determining a Machine's HOST ID** page, download the CPU_ID that supports your system (32-bit Windows or 64-bit Windows). Save the file and then follow the directions on the page to obtain your Host ID.
- 9. Return to the Free Downloads page, and find the Request License File section again. This time, click the link evaluation license key request form. Fill in the required information on the PTC Arbortext Evaluation form. You must provide your computer Host ID.
- 10. Click **Submit** to request the license. It will be emailed to you.
- 11. Check your email for the license key. Save the license key, as you will need it after finishing the installation process.

The key is valid for 14 days from the date of download and works only on the computer for which you provided the Host ID.

You are now ready to install PTC Arbortext Editor with Styler. The installation requires up to approximately 1.1 GB of disk space if all product options are included.

Please be aware of the following if you are installing on Microsoft Windows Vista and Windows 7:

- When you install PTC Arbortext Editor, a User Account Control dialog box appears asking whether you want the installation to proceed. Choose Allow to proceed with the installation. The dialog box is displayed even when you are logged on with administrator privileges.
- When you uninstall PTC Arbortext Editor from the Control Panel, a User Account
 Control dialog box appears stating that An unidentified program wants access to
 your computer. Choose Allow to proceed with the uninstall process.

Installing PTC Arbortext Editor with Styler

- 1. If you downloaded the .zip file from the PTC web site, extract the contents to a temporary directory on the computer where you will install. Find and run the windows\setup.exe program.
 - If you are installing from a DVD, insert it into your DVD drive. The setup program should run automatically. If it doesn't, go to the directory on the DVD for the version of PTC Arbortext Editor you are installing. Under its **windows** directory, run **setup.exe**.
- 2. The install program asks you to choose the language for your installation. Click **Next** to continue.

- **3.** The **License Agreement** is presented in your selected language. Choose **Accept** to continue with the installation.
- **4.** When asked to select a product to install, be sure to choose **PTC Arbortext Editor** with **Styler** to assure the license key will be compatible for your evaluation.
- **5.** From the **File Types** screen, accept the checked defaults.
- **6.** Choose one or more languages for the documentation you would like to include in PTC Arbortext Help Center.
- 7. Specify the destination folder for the installation.
- 8. Choose the **Setup Type** and click **Next** to continue.
- **9.** When asked if you will be using PTC Arbortext Publishing Engine, clear the check box and click **Next**.
- **10.** Click **Install** to proceed with the installation. The installation program will notify you that the installation is complete.

Installing the License

Your PTC Arbortext software needs the node-locked FlexNet trial license you requested from the PTC. The license file is attached to an email from PTC. Save the attached license file to a folder on the computer where you installed your software and remember the location.

Perform one of these actions:

- Create a PTC_D_LICENSE_FILE environment variable and set its value to the
 license file path. When you run PTC Arbortext software for the first time, it checks
 the path to the license as specified by PTC_D_LICENSE_FILE. If the path is not
 correct, you'll be prompted to provide it.
- Launch PTC Arbortext Editor from the PTC program group. When the **Licensing Error** dialog box appears, you can enter the license file path or browse to the file location. Click **Retry** to launch PTC Arbortext Editor. If it's successful, you can click **Save** to save the file location to the **PTC_D_LICENSE_FILE** environment variable.
