Cause	
Resolution	 The jscript.dll performance fixes are included in Internet Explorer 7.0+, Windows XP SP3, Microsoft Script 5.7, Windows Vista, Windows 7.0. The fix also requires Window Registry settings so if running one of these configurations, installing either hotfix is not necessary but setting the Windows registry settings is required.

!!Regardless of how a fix is obtained, the Windows Registry settings from this TPI must be set in all cases!!

If installing KB919237 on XP x64, request the hotfix for Server 2003 x64.

- Install the hotfix on the client machine. It can be installed manually or automatically via the use of login scripts, group policy tools or other patch management products.
- Add (create) the new Registry keys and values as documented in this TPI, not from the Microsoft article. Refer to Microsoft instructions and warnings regarding registry modification as detailed in KB919237 article. Perform registry modifications in ALL environments (i.e. IE6, IE7, IE8, Windows Script 5.7, Vista, Windows 7).
